



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs) ABOUT SPANISH NATIONAL DAY 2026

1. Do I need to confirm my attendance after I register?

- No. Your attendance is confirmed once you have registered and received your QR code.

2. What should I do if I do not receive my QR code after registering?

- If you have not received your QR code within 72 hours of registering, please check your spam or junk email folder. Capacity is limited, and QR codes will be issued in the order in which registrations are received. If all places have been allocated, you will be placed on a waiting list. You will receive a QR code if a place becomes available.

3. Can I give my invitation to someone else?

- No. Invitations are personal and cannot be transferred. Only the person registered with the Embassy of Spain in Abu Dhabi may enter the event. They must present their QR code and valid identification.

4. May I bring a guest?

- As capacity is limited, only people who have received an invitation and completed the registration process may attend. You may register your spouse as your guest on the registration form. You will each receive your own QR code.

5. What type of identification do I need to bring?

- To enter the event, you must present your QR code together with valid identification, such as your Emirates ID (EID) or another official identity document.

6. Can anyone under the age of 18 attend?

- Unfortunately, only people aged 18 or over may attend. The consumption of alcoholic beverages is also subject to local regulations.

7. Where can I park?

- Parking is available at Emirates Palace Mandarin Oriental. However, valet parking will not be available, to avoid delays. We recommend taking a taxi, especially if you are travelling from Abu Dhabi, to avoid congestion at the entrances. Taxis will also be available from the hotel at night.

8. What is the dress code for the event?

- Guests are asked to wear formal attire or traditional dress. Thank you for following the dress code.

9. May I enter the event before the scheduled opening time?

- No. The doors will open promptly at **7.30 pm**. Please plan your arrival accordingly.

10. What happens if I arrive late?

- You may still enter the event as long as you present your QR code and valid identification (EID/ID). The event will end at midnight.

Your data will not be shared with third parties or used for commercial purposes. All personal data will be processed in accordance with applicable data protection legislation and deleted after the event.
